

Emerging Choreographer's Concert

We are very excited about the upcoming Emerging Choreographers Concert. All interested dancers (choreographers) should complete the attached information sheet and return to the office in the folder marked Emerging Choreographers. There will also be a sign up sheet to reserve studio space. This will be posted on the company board on June 14th. Dancers may begin working in the studios as early as Monday, July 9th. Dancers will be responsible for organizing all choreography, setting rehearsal schedule, and communicating with the dancers chosen for the piece. Technical cue sheets and costume notes will be the responsibility of each choreographer. (I am more than happy to guide you through these steps- just ask!!!) Choreographers may submit more than one piece. Please fill out a different form for each piece you would like to submit.

The date for the concert is Saturday, September 8th. In addition to Giselle-Act 2 which will be set in August, Ms. Geary's piece (set in July), and an additional piece to be determined, we anticipate having approximately 6-8 student submissions. Keep in mind, selection of pieces is based on creativity and content. Note that we will be attempting to keep our program diverse....so consider choreography in different forms of dance other than modern! Ajudication of all works will be on Saturday, August 25th and selections will be posted on Monday, August 27th. Please feel free to send an email if you have any questions!

Choreographers, please limit the length of your pieces based on the level of dancers your are using as follows: (For example, a Junior company level choreographer using apprentice level dancers would limit the length to 2.5 minutes. An apprentice level choreographer using Sr-apprentice dancers would limit the piece to 4 minutes.)

Pre-Apprentice-Apprentice level dancers- 2.5 minutes Junior dancers- 3.5 minutes Sr App-4 minutes Senior- 5 minutes
